From time to time the SRA also utilise the funds received from members to augment services and maintain and improve existing facilities. Examples of this are the maintenance and beautifying of our public gardens, upgrade to facilities at Grannies Pool, improvements to the Main Beach facilities and repairs to the footpath on Captain Smith Road.
